

## **NAHE: The role of director**

The directors of NAHE are responsible for the activity of the association, ensuring that it is well run and delivers the outcomes for which it has been set up to achieve. They are accountable for the activities of the association. Although this is a volunteers, unpaid position, there are certain expectations of holding this position.

Each director should provide leadership to the association by:

- Upholding the vision and values of the association
- Setting the strategic direction to guide and direct the activities of the association
- Monitoring the activities of the association to ensure that they are in line with the vision and values
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Being a NAHE is an 'active' role and is much more than just coming along to meetings.

Expectations of directors:

- To endeavour to attend at least 50% of board meetings either by Zoom or in person
- Uphold terms within the constitution
- Actively promote the organisation and its activities on social media
- Volunteers for supporting or running at least one activity of the association per year
- Answer emails with requests for information/consultations in a timely manner
- Provide support/advice/guidance to other members of the association
- Volunteer for a role within the association e.g. communications, website, subject group organisation, governance, research etc
